## Guidance for those attending YHS events in the **Wauchope Hall**.

Dear all,

There are a number of obvious rules that the Wauchope Hall Committee asks us to follow, irksome though they may have seemed in happier times. They are for our own safety:

- 1) There is a hand sanitizer as you enter the Hall. Everyone entering is asked to use this on their hands.
- 2) Please wear a face-mask inside the building. You will need to keep it on throughout the talk and only take it off when you are outside the building.
- 3) Please observe the two metre distance rule as you enter and as you leave. In particular we are asked not to gather in groups and socialize inside the Hall either on entering or leaving.
- 4) Seats are set out at two metre distances except for a few set out in pairs for two people attending from the same household who can sit side by side.
- 5) Please give the person at the entrance your contact details. If you are on the YHS email list, we will have your email, otherwise please let us have your phone number.
- 6) If you have not already paid your membership fee for the year (the year runs from the AGM in February 2020 until the following AGM), then it might help to have your membership fee (£6) or the £2 payment for the evening's talk ready in cash to avoid unnecessary exchanges of money or conversation.
- 7) I am afraid there is a strict limit on the number of people allowed in the Hall and we have reached that limit, so no unexpected guests can be allowed in.

Apologies for these restrictive but necessary rules. We look forward to seeing you on Tuesday the 3<sup>rd</sup> November for a fascinating and informative talk.
